WHAT IS 2-BY-2?

In Mark 6:6-13, Jesus goes from village to village teaching the people. He then calls his disciples and sends them out 2-by-2, giving them different authorities. Verse 12 reads, "So the disciples went out, telling everyone they met to repent of their sins and turn to God." This Scripture is the model for our 2-by-2 work here in North Carolina: **Deaf reaching Deaf for Jesus!** Our journey includes:

- **Building relationships with local Deaf.** Our involvement with Deaf Senior Citizens (DCS), Deaf chats, and Deaf Night Out (DNO) has strengthened relationships among the Deaf.
- **ASL is the heart sign language of the local Deaf community.** We sign God's truth in our CBT studies, DCF, and in conversation.
- **Discipling new believers.** We meet with our new believers on a weekly basis, sometimes twice a week.
- **Helping establish local Deaf believers' fellowships.** We have formed one Deaf believers' fellowship called DCF. We want to train a Deaf man to lead this awesome group so we can form another Deaf believers' fellowship by the end of December 2017.
- **Identifying and training Deaf evangelists, teachers, and leaders.** No matter where we travel, this is a priority for us.

God is doing amazing things here in North Carolina! Deaf are being saved, becoming leaders, and reaching others for Christ. Three CBT studies are underway and three more are in the making. DCF is blooming with the gospel and much more!
