We have another change to tell you about. Since 2012, we have been seconded to DOOR (Deaf Opportunity OutReach) while working under Wycliffe Associates (WA). We have truly enjoyed working with DOOR and **beginning October 1, 2017, we will begin working directly for them.**



The main reason for this transition is the changes WA has made in their focus as a ministry. In the past, they were largely a mission set up to support the work of Bible translation. More recently, they have become directly involved in Bible translation through programs called MAST (Mobilized Assistance Supporting Translation) and DOT (Deaf Owned Translation). WA leaders were interested in assigning us to work in the new DOT program, but **we feel called to continue working with DOOR in the translation project here in Eurasia and future DOOR projects.** Since we have made this decision, it seems best for us to move organizations and work fully under DOOR.

We are very grateful to have been a part of Wycliffe Associates and their work in Bible translation. **We are appreciative of the many people who have become a part of our lives through Wycliffe Associates and how we have worked together in expanding the kingdom of God.**
