

HOW CAN WE REACH THE DEAF?

For millions of unreached Deaf, the path to spiritual transformation is through Scripture in their own heart language and well-equipped Deaf leaders.

SIGN LANGUAGE BIBLE TRANSLATION

Imagine that you grew up Deaf, with very little access to written or spoken information. If you encountered a book of the Bible for the first time, how would you make sense of things like sacrifice, redemption, prophets, or priests? You would have no context.

DOOR International's Deaf leadership team chose Chronological Bible Translation (CBT) as the most culturally-appropriate way to address this issue and share the Word of God with Deaf people worldwide.

Each CBT consists of 110 biblical narratives divided into three overlapping sets. Together, these narratives communicate how to know, follow, and serve God.

DEAF-LED CHURCH PLANTING

Evangelists, leaders, and teachers are needed to disciple new believers and share the Good News with unreached Deaf communities. Unfortunately, Deaf Christians have almost no access to God's Word. Access to training in evangelism, discipleship, and church planting is even less common.

To remedy this, DOOR helps recruit and train teams of two Deaf leaders from the local community (an evangelist and a teacher). Each pair is called a "2-by-2 team" and is equipped with training and a translation of God's Word in the local sign language. The teams are sent into Deaf communities to start Deaf believers' fellowships, share the Gospel, and train Deaf leaders.
