After packing up our belongings and saying farewell to the team we departed Eurasia on July 15th. It was sad to say goodbye, but we are excited to see what God has in our future. We had been planning to head to Kenya toward the end of this year. Now given the current situation, we are uncertain of the timing of our next move. We expect that we will be here in the US at least until January. We are happy to have the opportunity to help Raeleigh transition to life in America. We also hope we will have a chance to see many of you. During this time in the US, Josh will continue to work with the Eurasian translation team online.

why are the Deaf UNREACHED?

→ Limited access to information through written language

For 90% of Deaf people worldwide, learning to read a spoken language you can't hear is extremely difficult. Most Deaf people acquire very little information through written text.

→ Lack of published (video) Scripture

Out of the 350 sign languages around the world, less than 30 currently have any published Scripture.

→ Unrecognized leaders

Deaf people have little to no opportunity to use their spiritual gifts and are not recognized as possessing ability to lead.

Raeleigh is 18 now and Gabriel is just about to turn 16. They have both booked appointments to go take their driver's permit test.

Raeleigh is excited to start school at George Fox University. She loves languages (she is working on Bulgarian, Japanese, and Spanish), animals, and nature.

Gabriel will continue homeschooling. He loves guitar, computers, and wants to learn more about working on cars.
