



training resources

One of the greatest needs of Deaf translation teams globally is training resources. There are almost none available in any sign language. A new project that DOOR is starting soon will be developing sign language training materials that will teach how to set up a new translation team. They will give instruction in translation principles and practices and give training in the use of video equipment and editing software used in signed translations. When they are completed they will be available to new translation teams around the world for free. They will both improve the quality of translations and enable translations to move forward more efficiently and effectively. This is an exciting opportunity to advance Bible translation for Deaf communities.
