We are moving back to Kenya! Josh will be working with the Kenyan Sign Language (KSL) translation project. There are over 400,000 Deaf Kenyans and we are thrilled to be a part of bringing God's word to them in their heart language. The KSL Bible translation project is one of DOOR's first translation projects. They have completed 2 sets of 110 passages and are working on a third. Because they are further ahead in the translation process, other sign language projects are able to use the KSL translation as a resource as they translate the Bible.

We are excited to move back to Kenya this June. We will be living at the DOOR center in Ongata Rongai where we lived and worked while Josh did his initial training as a translation consultant. In fact, we will be living in the same house. It will be great to work alongside our old friends. Josh has already begun working with the KSL team long distance. He is enjoying checking the passages they have sent to him and giving feedback over Zoom, but he is especially eager to actually work with them in person again.

Audra will continue to homeschool Gabriel. He has two years of high school left. Raeleigh will be staying here in the US and continuing her studies at George Fox University. She is working toward a biology major but continues to have a multitude of interests, including a love for language and different cultures. She is hoping to do a semester abroad next year in South Korea.
