- Please pray for the team who Bobby is working with as they balance different projects.



THE BIBLE HAND PROJECT

This is evident as I, Bobby, witness different organizations partnering together to reach the Deaf community. Currently, the team who I am working with is working with another individual from the Wycliffe organization to develop Bible memorization materials. An example of a Bible memorization tool would be the song "Books of the Bible", but we want to develop materials that fit the Deaf community and culture.

The project is known as the "Bible Hand" project. Here's a sneak peek.

According to historical information from the Bible, it is believed that God's story with mankind has spanned about 6,000 years; however, the majority of the Bible covers 2,000 years in the middle. These 2,000 years can be shown using the hand, with the thumb representing Abraham, the pointer finger as Moses, the middle finger as King David, the ring finger as Ezra, and the pinky finger as Jesus. There is a span of around 500 years between each finger. There are 2,000 years of history before and after the hand, starting with Adam and Eve and continuing all the way to us in the present day.



This is just a small part of the Bible Hand project. We look forward to see all that comes from this project! We are so excited to be able to provide Biblical tools to Deaf communities to help them know, follow, and serve God more than ever before!

One of the projects we are working on is with the Jesus Film Project. They have asked us to take their video with a small interpreter in the corner and re-film it making the person bigger. This will make it easier for the Deaf to watch and understand the narrator and dialogue.

JESUS FILM

This will have a massive impact on the world. For example, just last month, my cousin, Andrew Miller, was able to host a group of Deaf missionaries from YWAM in Asia and they went to visit one Deaf man who did not know any sign language. The Deaf missionaries took this as an opportunity to use the Jesus Film to evangelize to the Deaf man. After a few hours, this man proclaimed to everybody in the street that he now had Jesus in his heart!

We are excited to see how God can use the Jesus Film project in sign language for His Kingdom!

TIMOTHY IS GROWING

Our son, Timothy, just became six months old; he is growing up quickly! Currently, he is starting to crawl and explore. His two front bottom teeth are starting to grow! We are very thankful for his good health.
