## GO TELL THE WORLD

Our journey began with two passages from the Bible, and is becoming more of a reality. In Luke 10, we have the story of Jesus sending out the seventy-two, and in Matthew 28, there is the Great Commission. We are called to go tell the world about Jesus. God has been opening doors for our Chronological Bible Translation (CBT) to be used more among the Deaf here in North Carolina and abroad. We are seeing the CBT be beneficial to people going out to train and plant new Deaf believers' fellowships and churches.

A sweet Deaf lady, Andrea, heard about Deaf Community Fellowship (DCF) and that we were using the CBT. **She came and observed us for a while; she was leery at first and gradually came to love it!** God called her to relocate back west where she shared her excitement about CBT with two Deaf churches! Both churches have reached out to me. I've been answering their questions via videophone (VP, a phone for Deaf people). **We've set up a time for my wife and I to travel to them for training and setting up a Deaf believers' fellowship. Praise the Lord! We will be leaving for Tucson, Arizona, in August.** The other Deaf church is located in California, and a tentative date is set for October. We're still communicating with them and answering questions.



Word of mouth (or hands!) is a great help. We got word of a church in Rocky Mount, NC with a Deaf ministry. Going through the proper channels with the church office and pastors, I was connected to Bobby Pierce, the Deaf ministry leader there. My wife and I are working alongside the pastors and Bobby, educating them about Deaf culture, answering their questions and planning for an establishment of a CBT group. **We are excited to see this become a reality! Prayers are greatly appreciated.**

My coworker Cindy, my wife Arlene, and I are now establishing a CBT group in a church in Chapel Hill, NC. Cindy reached out to them before the pandemic hit! A Deaf man who is familiar with CBT will be the teacher for this group. **Please be praying for James and me as I train him.**


