### GOD'S WORK ON DISPLAY

I was privileged to attend two camps this summer, with another one coming up this December.

One weeklong Deaf camp I attended recently was located 4 hours away, south from where I live, in the mountains. It was a beautiful location and the weather was lovely—cool and refreshing! **Approximately 150 Deaf people attended this camp, 27 of whom were nonbelievers. Four became Christians and were baptized!**

I greatly enjoyed this whole week of camp. It was a wonderful time of rest and renewal, being encouraged by the Word, worshipping, praying with and fellowshiping with other Deaf Christians who desired the Word of God. **I was challenged by their faith in healing and prophesy as well as their strong stand on the Word of God. Please pray for those who have not yet accepted Christ, that they will ask Jesus into their lives and be baptized.**

My highlight from this camp was interacting with several Deaf women from Romania & Ukraine who came to me, wanting to talk and ask questions about the Bible. One young Deaf woman, who is a relatively new Christian, shared with me that she did not know the Scriptures other than what she knew from attending church and learning from the New Testament. **The Old Testament was completely unfamiliar to her. Pray for her to continue growing in her faith.**

The second camp I went to this summer was the Wycliffe Romania Camp. This one had hearing attendees as well as Deaf attendees. I loved being an assistant cook for my colleague Jenny, helping to cook different Filipino food dishes. **The goal of the camp was to introduce mission work to potential missionaries.** As they participated, they had time to consider if they were still interested in joining Wycliffe to work in translation with either Deaf or hearing people.



I was also a part of the group who presented about sign language translation to the participants. I assisted with signing songs and shared about Deaf culture and our way of life.

I really enjoyed connecting with my colleagues and the participants alike, loving the very cool mountain air in spite of my sleeping and health challenges.

I've been invited to attend a camp this December located in Suceava in the northeastern part of Romania. I look forward to going and enjoying the snow in the mountains while getting to deeply enjoy the rich fellowship of Christ among the Deaf at Christmastime!

I am looking forward to hosting a female Deaf Consultant-in-Training in my home. She is coming from South America to work with a Bible sign language translation team in an undisclosed country and a certified consultant to finalize all of their videos before uploading them onto the internet.
