in their words

"When I was in high school I became very interested in knowing about God and Jesus. Unfortunately, although there were several hearing churches in my area, there was only one Deaf church and it was a Jehovah's Witness church. They came to our school on Saturdays and taught from the Bible. I was very eager to learn but as I compared their teaching with what I could understand of the written Bible I felt like something was off. The teaching didn't seem to match what I was seeing in the written text. But I wasn't sure since the text was hard for me to understand.

Fortunately, the next year a group from DOOR came to teach at our high school. I had struggled and struggled to try and understand the written scriptures but when I watched them sign the Bible it was clear and easy to grasp. It profoundly impacted my life and I am now a follower of Jesus.

After I finished high school I met with a group from DOOR again. This time it was during a community test where they brought drafted portions of scripture to show the Deaf community to ensure that the translation was clear and that the language made sense to us. While I was there I learned they were in the process of recruiting new signers for the project. I was so excited and I applied for the position. I was given the job and have been working with DOOR for a little over a year. Now I am helping my Deaf community understand God's life changing word."
