2023 PLANS

As we entered the year of 2023, the big picture of what Bobby would be doing was clear, but the details were murky. Only two doors remained open at the end of 2022, so Bobby will be involved with two projects: Translation Resources Training (TRT) and Consultant Empowerment, Development and Resources (CEDAR).

TRT is a year-long commitment to bring the translation resources videos we developed in the last two years to the field by going out and training sign language Bible translation teams. A few examples of the topics we will teach are Translation Principles, Sign Language Linguistics, and the history of Bible translation. The goal of this training is to help accelerate and improve the process of sign language Bible translation. Almost all of those teams have received little to no training in Bible translation, so this opportunity to train them would give them a rare chance to further their education and gain access to resources that they never had before. To give you an idea of how important this is, this would be the equivalent of—or even more than—being

CEDAR is a new program that DOOR launched with the goal of training sign language translation consultants and consultants-in-training (CITs). This program was established in response to one of the largest needs in the sign language Bible translation world. There are approximately 350+ sign languages in the world with 100 active projects and only about 20 translation consultants to assist with these projects. The remaining sign languages are pushing for projects to be started in their languages! The translation consultant is responsible for ensuring that the new Bible translation is as accurate as possible to the original Hebrew and Greek texts. CEDAR wants to find a way to train more Deaf people to receive the equivalent of a master's

a first-generation college student. We are excited for the life-transforming opportunities that will not just benefit the Bible translators but the Deaf communities they are working in.



degree and have competencies in sign language linguistics, Bible translation, Biblical exegesis, Biblical languages, and teamwork. Bobby is looking forward to beginning his training to help with the quality and accuracy of different sign language Bible translation projects.

With both TRT and CEDAR on the agenda for 2023, the details are still up in the air, so please pray for Bobby and his team as they try to navigate through scheduling for the upcoming training sessions and more in 2023. We appreciate your prayers and support more than you can know.
