TENNESSEE

On March 3-6, we drove to Kingsport, Tennessee to meet with some people who are interested in the Chronological Bible Translation (CBT). We were finally able to make a connection with a Deaf pastor and his Deaf wife, Chris and Donna. We tried to meet last October but were unable to do so.

Arlene and I attended their church, and enjoyed their worship service. There were around 70 Deaf people in attendance. After the service, we took Chris and Donna out to lunch, and we were able to discuss the possibility of using CBT in their church. They were very interested, wanting to learn more about CBT and how to use it to help Deaf people understand God's Word.







ARIZONA

On March 17-20, we went to Tucson, Arizona to provide further training for leaders, teachers, and evangelists for the Tucson Deaf Christian Church (TDCC). We also assisted in training the current leader and planning for the future as their church grows. They are expanding their knowledge as they reach and teach the Deaf in their area. In the training, we had two activities:

- Tower building: no communication was allowed in any form while they crafted a tower out of marshmallows and spaghetti noodles within a time limit of 25 minutes. This allowed us to see who potential leaders were.
- Jigsaw puzzle: communication was allowed while they pieced together a jigsaw puzzle and then shared their insights from it. This allowed us to see who could be teachers and/or evangelists.
