## HIS LOVE FOR DEAF + HEARING ALIKE

During the community checks of the sign language Bible videos in Romanian Sign Language, there were a couple of Deaf people who were paying careful attention to the stories. You could see understanding dawn on their faces when they understood different parts of the story. Sometimes they would ask what the meaning of a certain passage was. Then we were able to share and explain the meaning of that section.

For example, chapter 15 of the book of Mark is about Jesus' suffering. One of the Deaf people shared that he had never realized that Jesus did suffer a lot until he watched this passage because sign language is very visual with facial expressions showing the depth of the suffering. He now knows Jesus' love for people is very great! This community check had an impact on the Deaf people who received the translated book of Mark in their heart language, Romanian Sign Language.

We are planning to celebrate the completion of Mark and dedicate the translation of this Gospel on June 16th! Please pray for all the logistics and the planning that will go into this. Pray that the book of Mark will impact the Deaf community of Romania so they will know how much Jesus loves

them, enough to die and rise from the dead so He can forgive sin, conquer death and the grave so that we can have a relationship and eternal life with Him.



Please pray with us as the Romanian sign language Bible translation team begins translating parts of the Gospels of Matthew and of John. Pray for clarity, understanding and wisdom as they translate.
