GOD opens doors AT DEAFNATION EXPO

DeafNation Expo is a touring trade show for, by, and about Deaf people. Since 2003, the DeafNation Expo has attracted over one million attendees with hundreds of events throughout the United States.

Great things happened at DeafNation Expo on April 15th in Greensboro, North Carolina! There were more than 4,000 Deaf attendees. DeafNation has not been held in NC for almost ten years.

I thank God for Shayna, the newest evangelist on our team. When she learned that DeafNation was coming to NC in April, she immediately saw an opportunity to evangelize. She texted me earlier this year asking if our team could have a booth there to share the gospel and to show the Deaf attendees the Chronological Bible Translation (CBT) so they can learn about God's Word in their heart language.

We were on our feet constantly for about 10 hours interacting with the Deaf who stopped at our table. Many questions were asked and answered, and the

gospel shared. Many of the Deaf there were interested in the CBT and curious about how we use it to teach God's Word. I am grateful for the lives and hearts that were reached and touched.

We brought home a list of names and emails from those who wanted to know more. Some wanted us to contact them about times for future trainings, and others wanted to attend our Bible study on Zoom. I want to thank DOOR and their staff for all the amazing encouragement and support they gave us for this event.

YOUR Story MATTERS

I use this to network and to know where I can come alongside ministries. We introduce the use of the CBT to

reach the Deaf with God's Word in their heart language and empower them to reach their own people group. There are several listed in the state of NC on this app. However, we have been discovering that many of these ministries have been shut down. For example, I recently visited a church in Greensboro, excited to visit their Deaf-led Sunday school. Only two Deaf leaders were there, and the interpreted service that followed had no Deaf attendees. However, I am grateful that we had the opportunity to share the CBT and DOOR's methodology with the Deaf leaders. They are interested and we are going back to work with them.

Although some Deaf ministries are shutting down across the US, don't be discouraged. I believe God is preparing the soil in the hearts of the Deaf to receive the Word of God and He is opening doors for us to bring the tools needed to give the Deaf the opportunity to experience His Word in their heart language.
