DeafNation EXPO

After several months of anticipation, prayer, planning, and eagerness about reaching out to the Deaf community at the DeafNation Expo in North Carolina, God was present at the Greensboro Colosseum. Approximately 4,000 Deaf people, along with some hearing people, were in attendance. We set up two monitors at our booth, one showing clips from the Chronological Bible Translation (CBT), and the other had songs from Deaf Harbor. We had hand-outs as well: four different Chick cartoon tracts, business cards, lanyards, and more. The monitors and banners were very eye-catching—these drew the Deaf into the booth with many questions and gave us opportunities to share the methodology we use, etc.



We had some people sign up for follow-ups or to join our CBT study on Zoom on Thursday nights. I want to give a shout out to our evangelist, Shayna, who did an outstanding job sharing DOOR's methodology with others! My wife lost count after more than 300 people visited our booth because the interactions were ongoing and so lively.

God is so good, and let's give Him praise by entering His gates with thanksgiving. (Psalm 100:4)

THE JOB MOVIE IN ASL

In Chapel Hill during June, we had an event in which we showed the "Job" movie in ASL. Twenty-nine Deaf people were present, and this movie was a first-time experience for many when we discussed the movie afterwards. I had opportunities to chat with the people who attended and answered many of their questions. One woman approached me about salvation. She had believed it was a long, tedious and ritualistic practice. I explained to her that it was a free gift to us made possible by Jesus' laying down His life. We simply need to admit to Him that we have sinned and that sin has separated us from Him. We can then invite Him into our hearts as our Lord and Savior. **With wide eyes, she said: "That's it?" and I said yes!** She thought it over and I encouraged her to contact me after she had thought about it.
