THE BOOK OF MARK IN ROMANIAN SIGN LANGUAGE

As a staff member serving with SIL's Global Sign Languages Team (GSLT), I had the privilege and the opportunity to attend the celebration of the completion of the translated Gospel of Mark into Romanian Sign Language (LSR). It was an exciting time!

After several setbacks due to COVID and other struggles, we were finally able to publish the book of Mark in video format. I've been assisting the team by writing their quarterly narrative progress reports in English for the past three years. I really enjoyed doing this, giving them support and encouragement along the way.

During the dedication, the Romanian Sign Language Bible translation team (TBSR) were able to distribute the book of Mark in LSR on USB flash drives to Deaf church leaders and pastors here in Romania. Many of these leaders had been waiting expectantly for this translation. We were also able to give some flash drives to those who supported the work and were invited to the celebration. Pray that the Lord will bless this work and draw many Deaf Romanians to Christ.



One of the testimonies that stood out to me was shared by one of the Deaf leaders from Piatra Neamt. He is a Deaf pastor of a Deaf church there. He said that he had been waiting for this for a long time and had been asking when it would be completed. At the dedication, he was one of the first leaders to receive the USB flash drive containing the Gospel of Mark. He appreciated this so much and said it would assist him in sharing God's Word with the Deaf in his city.

Please pray for the TBSR as they now begin translating parts of the Gospels of Matthew and John.

While I was in the United States, I missed an opportunity to attend a SIL GSLT Mental Models Training workshop in Oradea, Romania for Europe.
