THE FAROE ISLANDS

I (Mark) traveled to the Faroe Islands for the European Deaf Christian Bible Translators Conference from October 30-November 4. The Faroe Islands are located between Iceland and Norway, in the North Atlantic Ocean. This country has more sheep than people!

This was the third bi-annual conference of its kind. The next one is in 2025 in Romania. Many different European countries were there to share tools and resources with each other to help with their Bible translation work. I was able to share about DOOR's work, and multiple countries expressed an interest in beginning their own Chronological Bible Translation (CBT) projects in their sign languages. Please join us in prayer that God would make a way for these countries to start their own translations.

It was a privilege for me to meet with many DOOR graduates from DOOR Europe who are still continuing to work in Deaf ministry. It is always a joy to see so many faithful servants gathered together in one place with a single mission in mind: to see every Deaf person have access to God's Word in their heart language.

One special moment is that, two days before her passing, she FaceTimed with Mark and signed an early "happy birthday" to him before he left for the Faroe Islands.


