## training new translation teams

One of the things I (Josh) am involved in is the training of new translation teams. Due to DOOR's extensive experience in sign language Bible translation and the lack of materials available for training new teams, DOOR has created a training syllabus and materials to help prepare new translation teams for the task of Bible translation. DOOR is also partnering with other Bible translation organizations to provide training to their new translation teams.

In January, a translation team arrived from Zambia. They will be here in Kenya for six months of training before they return to Zambia to begin translating the Bible into their sign language. It has been exciting to see their passion and to watch them grow as they are equipped for this important work.

This is only the beginning. Three other new translation teams are scheduled to attend training at DOOR this year. We are excited to see sign language Bible translations starting up in many new countries as more and more people become aware of this need. What an honor to be involved in making this happen.
