SEPTEMBER OF 2017

In September of 2017, I officially began to serve in the Kingdom of God through DOOR International. It's now been seven years of being involved with the mission of reaching Deaf for Christ. This past year, Leviticus 25:1-7 has been on my mind:

The Lord spoke to Moses at Mount Sinai: "Speak to the Israelites and tell them, 'When you enter the land that I am giving you, the land must observe a Sabbath to the Lord. Six years you may sow your field, and six years you may prune your vineyard and gather the produce, but in the seventh year the land must have a Sabbath of complete rest—a Sabbath to the Lord. You must not sow your field or prune your vineyard. You must not gather in the aftergrowth of your harvest and you must not pick the grapes of your unpruned vines; the land must have a year of complete rest. You may have the Sabbath produce of the land to eat—you, your male servant, your female servant, your hired worker, the resident foreigner who stays with you, your cattle, and the wild animals that are in your land—all its produce will be for you to eat.'" I have been taking the opportunity to pause and reflect on the amazing work God has done in Deaf communities around the world and my own life. As I share some of the wonderful deeds of God, I want to remind you that through your support—at whatever capacity—you are an important part of this miracle, glorifying God and advancing His Kingdom. *You are a part of the impact in the Kingdom of God!*



THE KID ZONE

Sienna just became two years old at the end of September and Timothy will be four at the end of November. They are excited for the arrival of their younger sibling in January.

In 2017, only about 20 sign languages in the world had parts of Scripture translated and distributed. Today, more than 50 sign languages have parts of the Bible translated and distributed. One of these sign languages has a full Bible translation, while another sign language has the equivalent of the New Testament in translation. Praise God for more of His Word being translated into the heart languages of the Deaf around the world. ***You are a part of the impact in the Kingdom of God!*** However, there are 350+ sign languages worldwide, so please continue to pray for God to send more workers into the Bible translation movement.

Since 2017, God has given me the following opportunities to:

- work alongside three different sign language Bible translation projects in some capacity
- provide Bible translation training for more than 30 Deaf Bible translation leaders from across the globe
- develop over 40 hours' worth of videos containing Biblical and Christian resources for the Deaf

This was not something that I could've accomplished on my own, but something that God has done through passionate and obedient people working together to follow His lead. Praise God for the beauty of how the body of Christ is capable of more together rather than individuals on their own! Once again, ***you are a part of the impact in the Kingdom of God!***

In 2017, I was a young single man who was ready to take the world by storm alone. However, that was not what God had planned for me. In 2019,

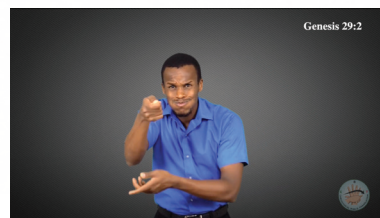
