- Faith Fest was a success this year as God brought many new Deaf and hearing people into our lives. Many of the interpreters have asked us to come to their church and share about the CBT. A Deaf man is also interested in CBT for his church. **My wife and I both had the opportunity to talk with Deaf people who had questions, learn about concerns in their lives, and pray with them.**



- Arlington First Baptist Church in Rocky Mount eagerly showed Jesus: A Deaf Missions Film. **After that viewing, 10 Deaf people came forward to learn more about our Savior through our Bible study on Wednesday evenings.** Slowly but surely, they're learning through the CBT that there's more going on behind the scenes than they realized. This is also true for those who watch our Bible studies on Facebook Live. They're on a fantastic journey on God's path!



- We have been blessed by the LORD using us to set up three new believers' fellowships in North Carolina. He has allowed us to travel and share the gospel with the Deaf, and train new groups of leaders, teachers, and evangelists. When we cannot travel, we provide training through Zoom, videophone (VP), Facebook Messenger, or whatever other means necessary to reach the Deaf for Christ. God is reaching and teaching the Deaf through the CBT, and it's amazing to see their eyes light up. **Their hearts are transformed, willing to learn more about Him who loves them, and they are willing to step up, so other Deaf can know Him like they now do.** Some of them are called to serve wherever God leads them! Praise the Lord!
