## CELEBRATING AND EXTENDING DOOR'S LEGACY

**Thank you for your support as we recognize that it's been some time since we provided an update.** A lot has been happening, and we're so grateful for an opportunity now to catch our breath and share some of the great things God has done.



**This year, DOOR has been celebrating our 40th anniversary in this ministry.** DOOR began as a local ministry to Deaf leaders in Texas. The ministry grew from the idea that God has gifted every believer to serve in His Kingdom, including Deaf people. From the beginning, DOOR has prioritized advancing Deaf leadership in order to see unreached Deaf communities reached with the good news of Jesus.



**This past August, our celebration activities began in Kenya.** Current and former staff gathered with Deaf leaders from 16 different countries and hundreds of local and national Deaf leaders, ministry partners, and friends to recount the many ways that God's goodness has been demonstrated throughout Africa.

From Kenya, our celebration turned to the US in October. We held an event in Grand Rapids, Michigan, for resource partners who have been instrumental in advancing DOOR's cause. **We heard the stories of Deaf leaders like Allan Orozco, DOOR's Deaf International Disciple-Making Director.** Each story detailed the power of a Deaf leader in their lives bringing the gospel to them, and the impact that seed now has on generations of Deaf people. **In total, DOOR has trained over 3,500 Deaf leaders and helped to plant over 1,000 Deaf churches. Praise God!**

We have another celebration for our leaders in South Asia in early 2025. Please pray alongside us that this time would be an incredible blessing for the staff, partners, and field leaders involved, and would inspire a vision for what God can do over the next 40 years and beyond.

This has also been a season of significant strategic planning for our leadership. Be on the lookout soon for details about where God is leading DOOR in the coming three years.
