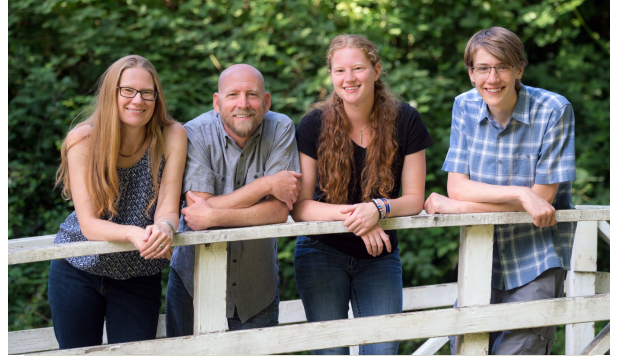

"I thank God for DOOR. I pray for DOOR, that the Lord will continue to pour out His strength and wisdom on all of the staff

here. You all are doing a mighty work. You are bringing light into the very dark places of Deaf communities throughout Africa. It is extremely difficult to be Deaf in Africa. We are devalued, oppressed, mistreated, marginalized, and alienated. I became Deaf at the age of 12, and did not accept my Deafness until I came here. Here I have learned that God accepts me as a Deaf person. He loves me. He forgives me. My entire life and perspective has been profoundly impacted and changed. I am a different person. I am committed to returning to my country to share this light and love with the Deaf people there by translating God's Word into sign language. Please don't forget us. Keep praying for us after we have left.

"In the past I had brief encounters with people who mentioned Jesus to me or tried to explain him to me, and each time, it sparked something in me, but I didn't fully understand. When I got here we started learning more about the Bible and about God and something was starting to happen in me. One evening, we watched the Deaf Jesus film, and that was it. I wept. Later I met with one of the leaders to talk about it. That's when I truly began to follow the Lord. I see Him working here, and am learning so many incredible new things. There's nothing

like this in my country. I really want to bring this back there to have an impact on the Deaf."

- ➔ Early in the year Josh worked with the Kenya Sign Language team helping them approve 20 Scripture passages and complete the current phase of their project.
- ➔ Josh traveled to work with the Aaela Mukdasa team in March. They were able to complete a community test and approve several passages of Scripture.
- ➔ We were blessed when a supporting church sent out one of their pastors and his wife to visit us. We loved having the opportunity for them to see our work first-hand and to get to know some of the Deaf here in Kenya. We had a great time hanging out with them and just being encouraged in the Lord.
