- **Pray** for Arlene's continued healing of her right shoulder. She's making progress, but it is slow.

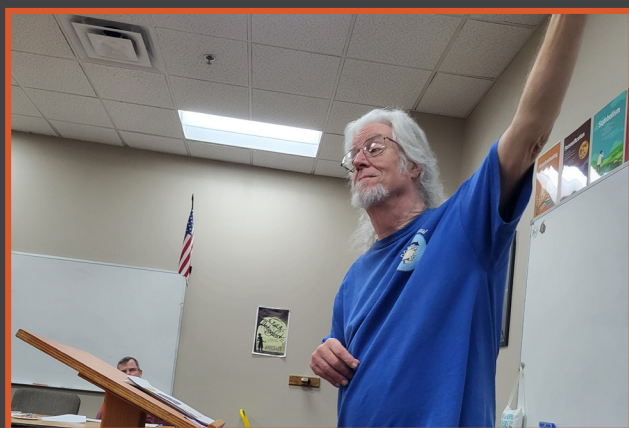
Rejoice

My wife and I visited the Triad Baptist Church Deaf ministry to finish some of the training from 2025. We were excited to see out of state Deaf leaders displaying interest, coming to that event to learn more about the CBT. Praise the Lord for those interested in CBT and bringing the new information they learned back to their Deaf communities so that more Deaf people can have access to God's Word in their heart language!



As we travel, Deaf people are approaching me and sharing, “We want more Chronological Bible Translation passages! We understand CBT but struggle to understand the interpreted services.” They are coming to the CBT studies and learning so much. Praise God as Deaf people are speaking up for what they need so that they can fully understand God’s Word.

Wilson, NC: We were informed that there were nine churches with Deaf ministries to the Deaf, and a Deaf-led church. Here are the results of our scouting:

- The **Deaf church** wants to continue the method they’ve been using in the past with their Deaf pastor.
- **Two churches** have interpreted services with no Deaf in attendance.
- **One church** provided someone to interpret for me the Sunday we attended. I was the only Deaf in attendance.
- **Six churches** no longer had Deaf ministries.

Deaf gatherings: There are three in our area. **One** Deaf gathering is still going strong and the other two exist, but have more hearing than Deaf in attendance.

Our future plans:

- To continue to assist at the Deaf Community Fellowship (DCF) as needed
- Wilmington, NC – connect with two churches
- Morganton, NC – connect with four churches
